Answers to 3 FAQs from New Taxpayers

Do I need to file an Income Tax Return?

You need to if any of these apply to you:

- You received a letter, form or SMS informing you to do so
- Your annual income in 2022 exceeded \$22,000
- Your annual net business income in 2022 exceeded \$6,000



I received an SMS on No-Filing Service (NFS). What does it mean?

If you have received an SMS that looks like this, you do not need to file an Income Tax Return.



SXXXXX: You are under the No-Filing Service for 2023. Do CHECK your pre-filled income and relief claims in your 2023 tax return at IRAS myTax Portal from 1 Mar to 18 Apr. If there are no changes to be made, you do not need to file a 2023 tax return.

Simply wait for your tax bill, or make adjustments to your income information or relief claims on myTax Portal.

Do I need to declare my employment income?

If your employer is participating in the Auto-Inclusion Scheme (AIS), you do not need to declare your employment income.

Your income information is submitted by your employer and pre-filled in your tax return.
