# **View Return Status (Partnership)**

### Q1. The status of my Return is shown as 'In Process'. When can I expect my Return to be processed?

A1. We process all income tax forms according to our assessing schedule and you should generally receive your partnership allocation notice by October.

#### Q2. The status of my Return is shown as 'Undelivered'. Why is this so?

A2. The income tax form (Form P) sent to you, based on the last known mailing address in our record, has been returned to our office as undelivered.

Please update your business address with the relevant authority, e.g. Accounting & Corporate Regulatory Authority of Singapore (ACRA).

If you wish to have your Tax Related correspondences forwarded to an address other than your Business Address, please get the Precedent Partner to write in to us at the following address to update us on your latest mailing address:

## Q3. When is the filing due date?

A3. You are required to e-file or complete the income tax form (Form P) and send it back to us by 15 April each year. If you do not submit your form on time, enforcement actions may be taken against you.

### Q4. What should I do if I cannot file my income tax by 15 April?

A4. If you require an extension of time, please write to us on or before 31 March, stating your reason and providing an estimate of your business income. We will evaluate your request and inform you on the outcome. If your request for extension of time has been granted, you may view the status of your request online under the 'Remarks' column.

# Q5. The status of my Return is shown as 'Processed' but I did not receive any partnership allocation notice from IRAS.

A5. If your partnership did not carry out any business in the preceding year, <u>no</u> partnership allocation notice will be issued. You may refer to the note under the 'Remarks' column. Otherwise, please call our Self-Employed Helpline 1800-356 8300 for assistance.

# Q6. The status of my Statement of Accounts is shown as 'Outstanding'. How do I submit my Statement of Accounts to IRAS.
