Mr Adam is currently the Managing Director and Head of Corporate Affairs, Citi Singapore and ASEAN. Mr Tan later served as a District Judge at Singapore's Subordinate Courts before being seconded to the Monetary Authority of Singapore, where he held appointments as Director of the Enforcement Division, Director of the Corporate Finance Division and Executive Director of the Investment Intermediaries Department. He was awarded the Public Administration (Silver) Medal in 2010.
