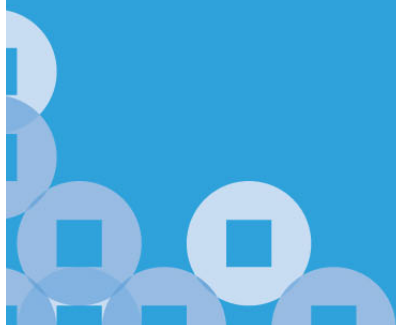

myTax Mail



Q1 What is *myTax Mail*?

A1 *myTax Mail* is a secure email channel for you to correspond with IRAS.

It is a safe and secure online environment for you to discuss your confidential tax matters with IRAS.

Taxpayers including authorised company staff and tax agents of both businesses and individuals can log in to myTax Portal > *myTax Mail* using their Singpass or Corppass to enquire about their tax matters.

Q2 Can I log in to myTax Portal to use *myTax Mail* on behalf of my spouse or friends?

A2 No. *myTax Mail* is a secure email channel for you to enquire about your confidential tax matters. Taxpayers should log in personally.

Q3 I am a company staff. Can I use *myTax Mail* to send an enquiry regarding my company/ clients' tax matters?

A3 Yes, you may do so if you are authorised via Corppass to transact with IRAS on behalf of your company/ client.

If you are not authorised under Corppass, you may visit IRAS website at www.iras.gov.sg and select 'Digital Services> Others > Corppass'.

Q4 I am a company staff authorised by my company/ client. Can the messages that I sent be viewed by my colleagues who have also been authorised?

A4 For message threads that you sent from 12 Aug 2024, authorised colleagues in the company will be able to view them

Q5 How do I know if IRAS has received my message?

A5 You will see a light-blue acknowledgement box at the top right hand corner after clicking on "Send Mail".

Alternatively, you may view the message that you have sent at:
For Individuals/ Individual Tax Agents, the message which you sent to IRAS can be seen at 'Inbox' > 'View Mailbox'

For Non-Individuals/ Non-Individual Tax Agents, the message which you sent to IRAS can be seen at 'Email Us (myTax Mail)' > 'Check Mailbox'

Q6 How do I know if IRAS has replied to my email?

A6 For enquiries on Individual Tax matters

We will usually respond to you within 5 working days. However, depending on the nature or complexity of your enquiries, we may need more time to review. If so, we will let you know.

Please update your local mobile number/ email address at Update Contact & Notification Preferences digital service accordingly.

For enquiries on Corporate Tax matters

We will usually respond to you within 5 to 15 working days. However, depending on the nature or complexity of your enquiries, we may need more time to review some cases. If so, we will let you know.




Please provide your contact details (email address or local mobile number) accordingly.

Q7 How long will the messages in *myTax Mail* be kept?

A7 All the messages in *myTax Mail* will be kept for 15 months. Thereafter, the messages will be automatically removed.
You can print or save a copy of the message for your own reference.

Q8 How do I know which message has been read or sent by me?

A8 Messages which you sent to IRAS or received from IRAS will be shown at:
i) 'Inbox' > 'View Mailbox' for Individuals/ Individual Tax Agents and
ii) Email Us (myTax Mail) > 'Check Mailbox' for Non-Individuals/ Non-Individual Tax Agents.

Q9 How do I view the messages in *myTax Mail*?

A9 You can read the messages by selecting the respective message at 'Inbox' > 'View Mailbox' for Individuals/ Individual Tax Agents and Email Us (myTax Mail) > 'Check Mailbox' for Non-Individuals/ Non-Individual Tax Agents.

Q10 Is there a time limit for composing an enquiry to IRAS?

A10 Yes. Please complete and submit your enquiry within 20 minutes.

Q11 What file(s) formats can I attach when I send an enquiry to IRAS?

A11 You can send up to 25 MSG/ PDF/ TIFF/ TIF/ JPEG/ JPG/ PNG/ DOC/ DOCX/ XLS/ XLSX attachments per message.

Each attachment must not exceed 10 MB per file with a file size of 50 MB per message.

Q12 Are there any guidelines on the filename to be used for attachment(s)?

A12 The file name must be in English and must not exceed 50 characters. It may, however, include numeric (e.g. birth cert_2010).

Q13 How do I convert my non-PDF file to PDF format?

A13 You would need to install a software to convert your file to PDF format. You may download the free software from <https://www.primopdf.com/>.

Q14 My attachment file is bigger than 10 MB. How can I send it to IRAS?

A14 If your file attachment is bigger than 10 MB, you can save the original document into separate files to reduce the file size. However, you can only send up to twenty-five file attachments each time with a total file size of 50 MB per message. Alternatively, you may send the documents to IRAS by post.

Q15 What software programs do I need to view the attachments in myTax Mail?

A15 If you selected the  [DOWNLOAD ALL](#) function, a ZIP file containing all the attachments will be downloaded and an unzip program is required to view the attachments. For PDF files, you will need to have Adobe Acrobat Reader to view the attachments.

Q16 Can I set the read messages to unread?

A16 No, this feature is not supported in *myTax Mail*.

Q17 Can I forward the messages in myTax Mail to my personal email account?

A17 No, this feature is not supported in *myTax Mail*.

Q18 How do I save a copy of the messages in myTax Mail to my computer?

A18 You can select  [SAVE AS PDF/ PRINT](#) in the MTM thread.

Q19 Can I delete any message in myTax Mail?

A19 No. Messages in *myTax Mail* cannot be deleted. Messages will be automatically removed after 15 months. You can print or save a copy of the message for your reference before it is removed.

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
